UPDATE

Fatality Pedestrian/Vehicle Accident

JOHNSTON, IOWA – UPDATE 3:00 PM /5.26.2021 – The pedestrian, Ga, has died from injuries sustained in the vehicle vs. pedestrian accident on Tuesday, May 25.

At this time, no charges have been filed against the driver of the vehicle. The accident remains under investigation and we do not anticipate any additional updates today.

PREVIOUS RELEASE: Tuesday, May 25, 2021 – At approximately 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday, May 25, 2021, a vehicle traveling southbound on Merle Hay Road struck 77-year-old, Kim J Ga, who was in the roadway at the 6100 block. She was transferred to the hospital after the medics arrived.

The driver of the vehicle remained at the scene and has been cooperative with police investigating the accident.

The pedestrian, Ga, is listed in stable condition at this time, according to her family.

The Johnston Police Department is working in conjunction with the Iowa State Patrol during this ongoing investigation. No charges have been filed against the driver at this time.
