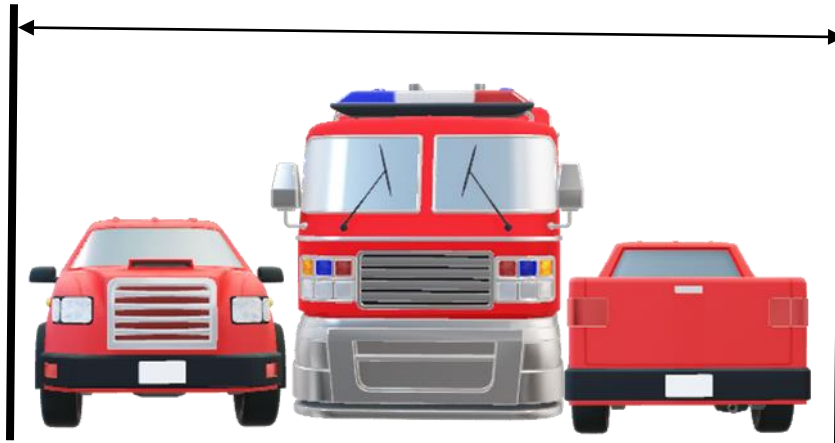


Fire Truck Access on a Typical 31 ft. wide collector street without parking restrictions



31 Ft. Street back of curb to back of curb	31 Ft.
Curb width 6" each side	$31' - 6" - 6" = 30$ Ft. travel portion of road
Legal Parking distance from curb 18"	$30' - 18" - 18" = 27$ Ft. for parking and travel
Width of average pickup 80" without mirrors	$27' - 6' 8" = 20$ Ft. 4 inches left for travel
Width of average pickup 80" without mirrors	$20' 4" - 6' 8" = 13$ Ft 8 inches left for travel
Width of Fire Truck 102" without mirrors	$13' 8" - 8' 6" = 5$ Ft 2 inches not including mirrors of any vehicles



NW 93rd Street and NW 94th Street

Below are a few dimension statistics regarding the design of NW 93rd Street and NW 94th Street and the standard level of service for new roadways constructed to this design.

- 31 foot wide roadway (typical residential collector)
- Roadway widens to 38 feet at the intersections with NW 54th Avenue and NW 62nd Avenue
- Approximately 1 mile in length (NW 54th Avenue to NW 62nd Avenue)
- 31 foot wide roadways are intended to convey two lanes of traffic and one parking lane.
- The widened sections of the roadway are intended to allow for additional turning lanes.

Since NW 93rd Street and NW 94th Street were constructed prior to current design standards, parking is permitted on both sides of the roadway (new streets constructed since 2006 are limited to one side parking). There still remains several parking restrictions that apply to all city streets in Johnston. Below is listed a selection of parking restrictions standard throughout Johnston. The full text of the City of Johnston Parking Regulations can be found in Chapter 69 of the Johnston Code of Ordinances.

- No parking on a crosswalk.
- No Parking within 20 feet on either side of a mailbox which is so placed and so equipped as to permit the depositing of mail from vehicles on the roadway.
- No parking in front of a private or public driveway.
- No parking within or within 10 feet of an intersection of any street.
- No parking within 5 feet of a fire hydrant.
- No parking within 10 feet of the approach to any flashing beacon, stop or yield sign, or traffic control signal located at the side of a roadway.
