RE: TRAIL SEGMENT REPLACEMENT SOUTH OF MORNINGSIDE DRIVE

The purpose of this letter is to invite you to a public meeting and project site walk through on two evenings early in February. The public meeting is scheduled for Thursday, February 6th at 5:30 p.m.

This meeting will be hosted at the Crown Point Community Center, 6300 Pioneer Parkway.

The purpose of this meeting is to look at the section of trail that starts at Morningside Drive and heads south until it "T"s. This section is scheduled to be torn out and replaced. The current design has a realignment of the trail with a curb and gutter system to minimize the amount of water that flows down the trail into the residents at the base of the trail. This plan does impact several trees and there is some concern with the loss of trees. We will discuss that option as well as the option of just a tear out and replace in the same general footprint as the existing trail. This would minimize (not completely eliminate) the tree impacts, but it doesn't address any storm water concerns. Any needed tree removal will begin later in February, so it is important to get as many opinions on this discussion as possible.

We are also planning a public walk-through of the site on Wednesday, February 19th at 5:00 p.m. We will meet at Morningside Park and get a visual look at the site. We will announce this at the meeting on the 6th, but it is also an option for anyone that may miss that public meeting.
