

What you should do if you have 4 or more domestic animals in your home? See questions below.

The municipal code allows no more than 4 animals in a dwelling unit. These animals may consist of dogs, cats, rabbits or similar animals in any combination.

This does not apply to smaller pets such as gerbils, hamsters, guinea pigs, mice, birds, snakes, ferrets and other similar animals maintained as pets and not for breeding purposes, inside a dwelling.

Larger animals such as pygmy goats or miniature horses are not allowed.

You should only count animals that are adult or over 10 weeks of age.
